A NOVENA OF PREPARATION

Holy Spirit, Divine Counselor,

Day 1: We pray first for all disciples, at all stages on our journeys of faith.

Let us pray for all those who are praying and working to create a vibrant, mission-driven and sustainable Church here in our diocese.

Day 2: For all priests, and for the pastors who lead and guide our parishes.
